



## Call Out – Choir Facilitator

The Customs House is looking for a practitioner to deliver choir sessions with members of the community at Perth Green Community Centre, Jarrow, to create a community choir with people with all levels of musical skill.

The practitioner should be able to work with people who have little or no previous experience in choir singing, have a supportive attitude towards participants skills and confidence-building, and value the wellbeing benefits of community arts.

The sessions would be 1.5h, run weekly for a period of 12 weeks, at 50£ per session. There is possibility of further work after these 12 weeks.

Sessions will take place in Perth Green Community Centre, with the possibility of working towards a performance at The Customs House.
